<p>Ingredient Definitions*:</p> <p><b>Bison</b> is a good solid meat.</p> <p><b>Lamb meal</b> is a high grade meat for dogs.</p> <p><b>Chicken meal</b> is another good meat source.</p> <p><b>Egg product</b>, it is good to see eggs this high on the list.</p> <p><b>Sweet potatoes</b> are an excellent source of vitamin A and a good source of potassium, vitamin C and B6</p>	<p>Ingredient Definitions*:</p> <p><b>Ground Yellow Corn</b> has been linked to many different problems within dogs including yeast infections to allergies. Corn is often difficult for dogs to digest and offers no nutritional value. You will find that none of our food at The Biscuit contains corn.</p> <p><b>Chicken By-Product meal</b> is also one we stay away from. It is hard to determine the quality of this ingredient. Chicken By-Products are usually lower quality parts of the chicken that are rejected for human consumption and usually contain the 4 D's (Dead, Diseased, Dying and Disabled). (EWWWW!)</p> <p><b>Corn</b> (again!) in the form of a Gluten meal, which basically means after everything that may be nutritious has been removed from corn, they take what's left over and call it Gluten Meal.</p> <p><b>Soy Bean Hulls</b> are considered to be a very low quality filler. Soy Bean hulls are the outer casing of the soy bean, and offer nothing to the dog food.</p> <p><b>Whole Wheat</b> is another item not found in the dog foods we carry. Whole Wheat flour is one ingredient that has been linked to numerous cases of dog allergies.</p>
